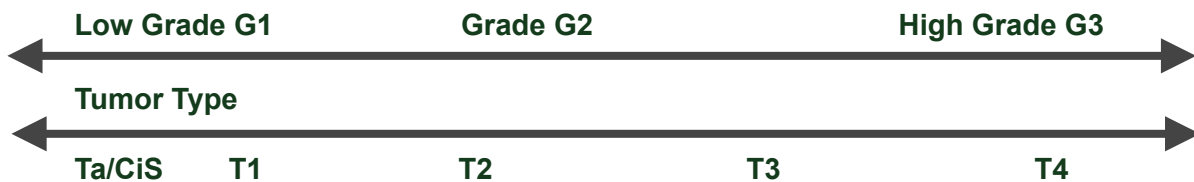

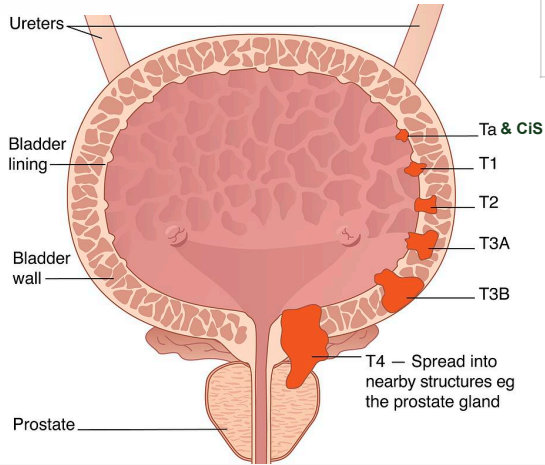

- Ta & CiS: Non invasive papillary carcinoma or Carcinoma in Situ
- Stage 1: The tumour has grown into the Bladder tissue
- Stage 2: The tumour has grown into the muscle layer of the bladder
- Stage 3: The tumour is locally advanced towards or into the fat
- Stage 4: The tumour has advanced beyond the bladder
